Brantley — Homecoming Daygown and Bonnet

Yardages:

The measurements below are *liberal estimates*. Exact measurement of pattern pieces may result in the purchase of *less* yardage.

Daygown

45" fabric: 1 1/2 yd.

Vertical strips of insertion: 3/4 yd. per row

Flat trim for hemline: 1 1/4 yd.

Notions: For placket: 3 - 1/4" buttons and 2 nylon snaps; for back button closing: 5 - 6 - 1/4" buttons and 2 nylon snaps.

Bonnet

45" fabric: 1/3 yd.

Trim for bonnet band: 1/3 yd. per strip Trim for front of bonnet: 1/2 yd. per row


Trim for sides of bonnet: 1/2 yd.

1/4" wide double-faced satin ribbon: 2/3 yd. 5/8" wide double-faced satin ribbon: 1 1/8 yd.


