



Baby Boy's Smocked Bonnet

Newborn to 32 lbs.

A smocked baby bonnet just for boys! sized for newborn to 32 lb babies. The pattern includes two smocking design plates and suggestions for conversion to an heirloom sewn look.

Sizing: Weight: Newborn to 11lb. 14 lb. 20 lb. 26 lb. 32 lb.
Head circumference: 15" 17" 18" 19" 19 1/2"

Materials:

2/3 yd. light weight fabric such as Swiss or Imperial Batiste,
Medium weight interfacing (about 5" x 10")
2yd. Mini piping (or make your own)
1/3 yd. Ribbon, 1/2" wide for strap (or make your own of self fabric)
Velcro® dome, snap, flat button or buckle
Totally Stable® iron on tear away stabilizer and/or *Wonderunder®*,
paper backed fusible web in a roll (3/4" width)
Embroidery floss, embroidery/crewel needles, sewing thread to match
scissors, pinking sheers, pleater, thread, pins, tissue and pencil for
tracing pattern, sewing machine.

Suggested fabrics: Swiss batiste, cotton blend batiste, broadcloth,
linen, pinwale corduroy, velveteen, silks, baby cord, piqué, fine wool
and wool blends (Note: smocked panel and lining for heavier weight
bonnets should be cut from matching lightweight fabrics.)

Suggested alternate panel techniques: Smocking, heirloom
sewing, quilting, Interlace, white work, shadow embroidery, cutwork,
Madeira, hardanger, cross-stitch etc.
