

Old Fashioned Baby Bonnets

"Old Fashioned Baby Bonnets" is a collection of five beautiful bonnets. The Lacy Peek a Boo is a T - Shape that ties together with ribbon. The Hanky Bonnet is designed for baby to wear and then later when he/she marries, it can be made back into a hanky to be carried down the aisle by the bride. It comes with an embroidery design, poem and instructions for pinstitching. Antique Christening Bonnet is fashioned after a bonnet made in the 1920's. It has lace insertion alternating with embroidery, and has fabric ties. The Little French Bonnet is a quick and easy version of an old favorite. The Little Scalloped Cap is perfect for a little boy. It has a chin strap and is lined. A touch of embroidery sets it off.

Hanky Bonnet

12X12" (14X14" for Lg.) Square of Linen or Batiste

1/8" Ribbon - 1/2 yd

1/2" Ribbon - 1 yd

1/2" wide Lace edging or tatting - 1 1/3 yd (1 2/3 yd for Lg.)

Little Scalloped Cap

1/4 yd Fabric - Wool, Corduroy, Batiste or Broadcloth

1/4 yd lining - Wool, Batiste, Flannel

1/2" Button - 1

Little French Bonnet

1/3 yd Fabric - Batiste or Organdy

1/2" Lace Insertion - 7/8 yd

3/4" Lace Insertion - 1/2 yd

3/4" Lace Edging - 3 yds

Entredeux - 2 yards

1/4" ribbon - 1/2 yd

Antique Christening Bonnet

Fabric - 1/3 yd Batiste or Organdy

1/2" wide Lace Insertion - 1 5/8 yd

3/4" wide Lace Edging - 3 yards

Entredeux - 3/4 yd

Peek a Boo Bonnet
