Giraffe fabrics: 5 fat quarters OR 5 fabrics from the bolt Fabrics 1 & 4: 3/8 yd each Fabrics 2, 3 & 5: 1/2 yd each View B- four fabric giraffe

Giraffe fabrics: 4 fat quarters OR 4 fabrics from the bolt Fabrics 1, 2 & 4: 1/2 yd each Fabric 3: 3/8 yd each

All Views:

Numbers fabric: 1/3 yd accent fabric

2 yds of 36" to 45" wide fabric Background fabric: Backing fabric: 5/8 yd (will not show in finished project)

Giraffe can be attached to the background with machine embroidery OR with bias binding If using embroidery you will need the following: Bias Trim fabric: 1/3 yd coordinating fabric OR 1 pkg. purchased coordinating single fold bias tape If using bias binding you will need the following: Bias Trim fabric: 1/2 yd to 1 yd coordinating fabric (more yds. means fewer seams in the binding) OR 2 pkg. purchased coordinating single fold bias tape

Required supplies:

All views: threads that match the bias trim, background and numbers; 2 yds heavy, fusible interfacing, one $\frac{3}{4}$ " and one $\frac{3}{8}$ " buttons for the eye (one will be sewn on top of the other) Optional: spray adhesive

Suggested fabrics: cottons including flannels
