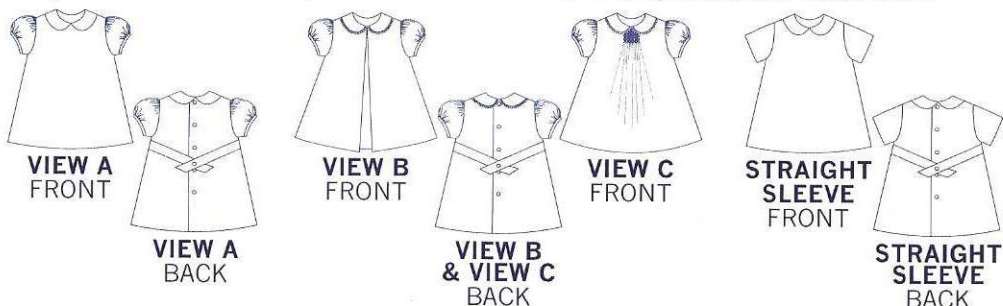
The Carol pattern is a traditional A-line apron pattern that buttons in the back. VIEW A has a plain front, VIEW B has an inverted box pleat, and VIEW C has a small section of smocking. All views include a puff or straight sleeve and Peter Pan collar with piping or gathered trim and an optional belt.

**SUGGESTED FABRICS:** Light to medium-weight woven fabrics like broadcloth, chambray, corduroy, lawn or pique.

## NOTIONS:

- Buttons (3/8") – Sizes 6mo-3, see chart
- Buttons (1/2") – Sizes 4-6, see chart
- Piping – 1 yard
- Gathered Trim – see chart
- Featherweight fusible interfacing

**REQUIREMENTS:** Fabric quantities allow for nap and optional self ruffle trim.
