* Osweet Little Kisses *

Cute, pert and easy to wear this little girl's mini dress is suitable for good quality interlock knits as well as good quality cotton or other easy care fabrics. It features very simple styling with bias bound scoop neckline and little cap sleeves. Dress front is gathered into the neckline and the sleeves are slightly gathered at the cap. With an easy back opening, underarm pleats add a bit of fullness to the skirt. Optional pocket included. Dress can also be made sleeveless with armhole binding. Team it up with leggings, tights or shorts if you like. Or treat it like a jumper and add a long sleeved onesie. See the Designer's Tips on the large pattern sheet for more ideas for making this little dress 'your own'.

Dress Fabric (45" or 60" width)

Sizes 1 & 2: 3/4 yd. Sizes 4 & 6: 1 yd.

Contrast Fabric for Bias Binding (45" width)
All Sizes: 1/2 vd.

Chest Measure	19"	21"	23"	25"
Finished Dress Length from Bk Nk	15"	16"	19"	23"

Additional Supplies: Tissue paper and pencil for tracing pattern pieces; 18" ruler and yard stick for pattern extensions; thread to match fabric(s); fresh sewing machine needle #70 (ballpoint for knits); scissors; fine hand sewing needle; plastic snap, hook & eye size 2, 8" (20cm) invisible zipper or flat button; 1 pkg. medium weight tearaway stabilizer.

Optional: 3.0 twin needle for hemming; an extra bobbin; serger to finish seam allowances quickly; 1/4" quilting foot, 5 groove tucking foot to install invisible zipper; 1 yd. iron-on stabilizer tape for applying zipper. (See "Designer's Tips" for instructions).

Suggested fabrics: Cotton or poly/cotton blend broadcloth or firm knit fabric; prints, plaids and coordinating fabrics for dress and trims.

Good quality firm knits are easier to sew in this pattern.

Use a coordinating woven for the bias bindings for stability.
