This sweet and flattering dress features a cut-out scoop neck-line, an above-the-knee hemline, pockets and shirring in the back for an easy, comfortable fit. No zippers or closures are needed, making it a wonderful project for the intermediate sewist!

Pattern includes clear, step-by-step instructions and diagrams, a fit guide and plenty of tips and hints throughout for techniques such as shirring with elastic thread and sewing darts.

MATERIALS

- Light- to medium-weight cotton or cotton-blend fabric such as shirting, voile, double gauze, quilting cotton, poplin or cotton-linen blends
- 1 1/4 yard prepackaged single-fold bias tape (or cut your own 1 1/4"-wide strips)
